**Department of Utilities provided update:**

- Freemason/Yarmouth paving done
- Couple of months of work still left in Freemason area
- Brambleton Ave work continues, installing water line under light rail bridge

**Heather Stein, Hampton Roads Transit, provided update:**

- On W.York Street, south side work almost complete
- Middle of this week, curb and gutter work will begin
- Virginia Natural Gas is finishing their work on York Street & Verizon relocations will start this week
- Kirn demo will start 3<sup>rd</sup> week of June
  - Question about why west bound plume street lane is closed
    - Heather Stein & Paul Filion have agreed to look into it
- Work continues on Monticello
  - Comment was made that it looks like there is not work being done
  - Heather Stein will provide an update on Monticello work tomorrow to the MacArthur Center

**Freeda Burns, City of Norfolk, provided update:**

- Skanska working at Government plaza, need to relocate a water line because of new court complex
- St. Paul's & Plume work starts 6/8 will last 7-10 days, police officers & times traffic signals will help with detours
- City hall & Court partial lane closure due to water line stop
- DVP work near Norfolk Southern garage, will try to have Skanska and DVP work together so that there are not 2 interruptions.
- Granby Street, jack hammering was being done at 11pm, crews thought this was authorized, problem solved
- Wed. evening from Bute & Granby to Monastery restaurant will be a full closure
- Granby Street work permit is for 6/1 to 6/25. May be done in 14 days

**Open Discussion**

- Freeda Burns said that as a rule of thumb, when work is being done on East and West bound streets like Plume, Waterside Drive and City Hall must be open and when work is being done on North and South bound streets like Boush Street, Monticello and Granby will be open.
