



NEW WORK

BRAMBLETON AVENUE

- INSTALLATION OF HANDRAIL ON LRT BRIDGE WILL CLOSE ONE EAST BOUND LANE BETWEEN COLLEY AVENUE AND BOTETOURT AT NIGHT.

YORK STREET

- WORK WILL START ON STREET LIGHT PREPARATIONS NEXT MONDAY, APRIL 19
 - CREWS WILL BE REMOVING THE CONCRETE BASE MATERIAL UNDER THE BRICKS
 - THE BRICKS WILL BE PUT BACK IN PLACE UNTIL INSTALLATION BY DOMINION VIRGINIA POWER OCCURS
 - EXPECT SHIFTING PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

BOUSH STREET

- WORK WILL START ON PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALKS AFTER THE CITY HALL CROSSING IS COMPLETE
 - WORK WILL TAKE APPROXIMATELY 2 WEEKS AND START AFTER 7 P.M.
 - EXPECT ALTERNATING LANE CLOSURES AND SHIFTING PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

CHARLOTTE STREET

- SIDEWALK WORK AROUND BAXTER'S WILL FINISH EARLY IN THE WEEK AND WILL PROGRESS TO THE AREA SURROUNDING 456 FISH
 - WOODEN WALKWAYS ARE IN PLACE AT GRANBY/CHARLOTTE AND WEBSTER'S COURT

MONTICELLO AVENUE

- WORK WILL START ON PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALKS AT FREEMASON, MARKET AND CITY HALL INTERSECTIONS AFTER THE CITY HALL CROSSING IS COMPLETE
 - WORK WILL TAKE APPROXIMATELY 2 WEEKS AND START AFTER 10 P.M.
 - EXPECT ALTERNATING LANE CLOSURES AND SHIFTING PEDESTRIAN ACCESS

SAINT PAUL'S BOULEVARD

TRACK INSTALLATION WILL CONTINUE ON SAINT PAUL'S BLVD. (AT PLUME STREET) THROUGH MID- MAY

PLUME STREET

TRACK INSTALLATION WILL CONTINUE THROUGH APRIL AND SHOULD WRAP UP EARLY IN MAY. PLUME/BANK INTERSECTION IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE THROUGH THE END OF MAY

CITY HALL AVENUE

TRACK INSTALLATION ON CITY HALL AVENUE EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETE MID- MAY.

MONTICELLO AVENUE

TRACK INSTALLATION IS COMPLETE

CHARLOTTE STREET

WORK IS EXPECTED TO CONTINUE THROUGH JUNE

BUTE STREET—BOUSH STREET TO DUKE STREET

TRACK INSTALLATION IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETE EARLY TO MID MAY
